Muhammad Mehr Ali, Ex-Vice Chairman, PTA met Mr. Abdul Razak Dawood Advisor to PM on Commerce in Ministry of Commerce, Islamabad on 26th December'2019 to discuss Leather Industry's issues for resolution.

Besides above, on the same day Mr. Khurshid Alam, Ex-Chairman, PTA also met the Honourable Prime Minister of Pakistan, Mr. Imran Khan in Bani Gala Islamabad to discuss various core issues as confronted by the Leather Industry and specially highlighted the issue of smuggling of live animals from Pakistan to Afghanistan which adversely increasing the prices of meat and livestock in Pakistan and hampering the leather industry badly as well.

Muhammad Mehr Ali and Mr. Muhammad Ali-SG, PTA met Mr. Abdul Razak Dawood, Advisor to PM on Commerce on 2nd January'2020 in Ministry of Commerce, Islamabad to discuss all core issues being confronted by the Leather Industry and the details of issues are as

Livestock smuggling from Pakistan :

Which is vital one as brought to the notice by Mr. Khurshid Alam with facts & figures to the Advisor to PM on Commerce, he assured to take more strict surveillance to refrain, which is precious for the leather industry and harmful for the country and necessary measures have also been directed during the meeting in coordination with PTA.

To rationalization Tariff of CD, ACD, ST/AGST etc., etc.

PTA was informed that NTC (National Tariff Commission of Pakistan) is being merged with MOC to enable them in future very shortly to finalise the duties structure with certain relax features would be made/decided by MOC for the best interest of all export sectors including Leather.

To provide Level Playing Field to Leather Sector

In response to our above proposal, the Advisor on Commerce informed PTA delegation that MoC is making necessary measures for providing level playing field to all core sectors of the country including Leather Sector in the next Federal Budget 2020-21 which is expected in June'2020 and he also keen to relax the duty structure particularly on Chemicals for Leather Sector to make this more viable at international platform.

To release DLTL refund claims to Leather Sector

The Advisor on Commerce assured PTA that all the claims for previous DLTL claims would be released to Non Textile Sector in January'2020 with sufficient fund allocation to SBP for further proceeding.

To Finished Leather/Dyed leather inclusion in new DLTL

PTA delegation apprised the Advisor on Commerce about the elimination of Finished/Dyed Leather from DLTL Scheme FY 2018-21 without consultation with the major stakeholder of the Leather Sector while the other sectors are remain part of the DLTL scheme due to this un-favourable decision, the export of Finished Leather Sector is gradually declined which is vital for Leather for expansion of exports & keep retain our share in int'l market and even to accelerate it to the maximum extent as per aspiration of the Government.

The Advisor on Commerce realized the situation and assured to resolve the issue soon.

To grant fund for Rs.133 Million out of total expenditure for Rs.485 Million for organizing 10-Int'l Fairs as allocated by TDAP to PTA's Member Participants

PTA delegation recall the Advisor on Commerce about his approval of 80% Subsidy on allocation of Int'l Fairs to PTA for organizing National Pavilion in various destination during the previous meeting held with him on 18th September'2019 but the implementation on the decision is still awaiting. PTA again submitted Budget on Int'l Fairs with detail presentation during the meeting for allocation of fund to PTA for Rs.133 Million out of total 100% expenditure for Rs.485 Million and stressed to issue instruction to TDAP for granting fund for organizing 10 Int'l Fairs in various destinations as allocated to PTA irrespective of 2 times & 5 years participation condition as per approval of MoC. The advisor on Commerce assured PTA for consideration of PTA's above proposal with the authorities concerned.

To Compliance / NEQS

The issue of Compliance / NEQS was also came under discussion in detail for which the Advisor on Commerce has issued directives for the study in coordination with PTA for proceeding further due to its importance as a vital element for export of Leather and Leather Products from Pakistan.

To announce Technology Up-gradation Programme by the MoC

Mr. Abdul Razak Dawood, Advisor on Commerce informed PTA delegation during the meeting that Ministry of Commerce will announce a Technology Up-gradation Programme & Bonded Wahre-House Scheme abroad in June'2020 for all core export sectors including Leather which will be productive for the promotion of export specially Leather.

To adopt No-Duty No-Drawback System

During the Meeting, Chairman, PTA, Sh. Afzal Hussain also proposed to consider the mode for "No-Duty No-Drawback System", which was appreciated by the Advisor Commerce and assured that the MOC is moving towards to extend maximum relaxation in the Tariff specially fundamental Chemicals for Leather to be allowed at Zero rated in first phase hopefully within the current year and rest could also be considered favorably for the next year.

In due deliberation, a detailed power point presentation was delivered by Mr. Agha Saiddain, Ex-Chairman, PTA to the Advisor on Commerce wherein highlighted all areas of the leather sector specially Finished Leather plight which was highly appreciated by the House particularly the Advisor on Commerce who seen each page of presentation carefully and got the clarification which was given by Mr. Agha Saiddain to him with satisfaction.



At the conclusion of the meeting Mr. Abdul Razak Dawood, Advisor on Commerce shown his intension to give priority to Leather Sector of Pakistan which is a core industry of the country and assured to extend all maximum possible cooperation for the survival of this Industry and realized the great potentials for the expansion & promotion of Leather exports.

He also informed that the MoC is being finalized the formation of Leather Export Promotion Council (LEPC) as per mutual understanding agreement between all stakeholders of Leather Sector and inviting 6 names from PTA for finished leather for inclusion in the proposed LEPC to proceed further in this regard to become it effective for leather sector of Pakistan.

Meeting of PTA Delegation with DG-IOCO, KARACHI on 14.01.2020

PTA Delegation led by Mr. Anjum Zafar, Chairman, Export and Taxes Standing Committee, PTA alongwith Mr. Hamid Arshad Zahur held meeting with the Director General, IOCO, Karachi and his team on 14th January'2020 to discuss new worksheets as submitted by PTA to IOCO in detail.

The DG-IOCO raised different queries on these work sheets, Mr. Anjum Zafar fully addressed and answered him confidently. Some more details on import data were required by IOCO officials for which we will work out and submit to them.

Mr. Anjum Zafar had a very detailed discussion with IOCO on FOB prices where major difference was dound. When Mr. Anjum Zafar checked IOCO export data working, it was not worked out properly by IOCO and he pointed out their mistakes. Mr. Hamid Arshad Zahur from PTA was authorized to sit together with IOCO team and rectify the export data which he will be attending and will keep PTA informed.

Finally DG-IOCO issued instructions to his team to correct their mistakes in shortest possible time and he promised to get in touch with PTA after this is done.

- To release of pending Claims for DLTL: The Advisor on Commerce assured to make it expedite for the desired release to PTA members in next week.
- To withdraw ban import of Pickled/Wetblue Cow/Buffalo Hides & Goat Skins: The Advisor on Commerce issues instruction to the Official concerned for immediate removal of the ban imposed unnecessary. Accordingly, the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation and Coordination and Ministry of Commerce issued Officials Memorandum and clarification vide their letter dated 25th & 26th February respectively in this regard for removal of ban on import of pickled/wetblue cow/buffalo hides & goat skins from China.
- To remove Quarantine requirement on import of raw, pickled/ wetblue hides & skins as imposed by the Ministry of Commerce through SRO 1067(I)/2017 dated 20th October'2017: The official concerned of the Ministry of Commerce assured for further consideration and resolution.


Local Trade visitors/buyers


