PTA'S MEMBERS' PARTICIPATION UNDER THE UMBRELLA OF PAKISTAN PAVILION IN ASIA PACIFIC LEATHER FAIR-2022

APLF 35+ years being held in Hong Kong, the Organizer announced that APLF-Leather and Materials+ 2022 will be relocated from Hong Kong to Dubai, UAE, from 30 March – 1 April 2022 at the Dubai World Trade Centre (DWTC)**due to COVID-19 outbreak.It** is the first time that the world's leading leather show was being held outside its home city.



The result was a series of lockdowns, international travel restrictions and compulsory quarantine of up to 14 days in many countries for arriving travelers particularly in Hong Kong. Thus, ongoing restrictions in Hong Kong caused successive postponements of APLF and as a result the Organizers took the decision to move the fair to Dubai as the best alternative location for the 2022 event.

Being the most productive / well renowned fair of its kind in Asia the Asia Pacific Leather Fair-2022 (APLF) onleatherandleatherproducts, Pakistan Tanners Association (PTA) which is representing the 2nd largest export oriented industry of Pakistan has organized participation of its member exporters as a regular feature in this event of APLF held from 30^{th} March – 1^{st} April'2022 in Dubai for the exposition of finest quality of valued added Pakistani FinishedLeatherof Sheep,Goat,Cow&Buffalowhichare catered to the manufacturing Leather Shoes,LeatherGarments/Products/goods/furniture's etc.etc.

ALLOCATION OFASIA PACIFIC LEATHER FAIR (APLF)-2022 TO PTA OUT OF 10 INT'L FAIRS LIST SUBMITTED TO EDF / MOC

We are very thankful to the **EDF/MOC** for the approval with allocation of required funds made **during the EDF Board Meeting held on 16.06.2021** at Islamabad with the **approval of 3 Initial Fairsout of 10 Int'l leather Fairs list submitted to MoC,** while this fair was one of them approved for APLF'2022, Dubai, UAEfor organizing National Pavilion of Pakistan for wide marketing &promotion of exports of Leather Sector of Pakistan.

PRIOR DISSEMINATION OF PTA'S MEMBERS PARTICIPATION INTERNATIONALLY BEFORE COMMENCEMENT OF THE APLF-2022 IN DUBAI AND WORLDWIDE

After completion for all prior cordial formalities, PTA had submitted the list of **25 final member participants** with all their credential specially prescribed applications form with bank export performance certificates, NTN copies etc., etc., to TDAP, Karachi well before time for commencement of the Fair and accordingly circulated widely at Dubai the information of participants thru **Consulate General of Pakistan, UAE** amongst the potential buyers/customers to visit Pakistani Booths during the APLF-2022 at Dubai. PTA had also circulated/sent the information of participants to rest of the Pakistan Consulate/Embassies, Federations, Chambers and Trade Associations at destinations of the world for circulation so that maximum traffic of foreign buyers/customers could be obtained during the Fair for the desired conclusion of enormous business at respective Pakistani booths during the Fair at Dubai.

PAKISTAN PAVILION IN APLF-2022, DUBAI THE FIRST APLF IN THREE YEARS ALSO HELDFOR THE FIRST TIME OUTSIDE HONG KONG STARTED FROM 30TH MARCH 2022 AT DUBAI WORLD TRADE CENTRE

Pakistan Pavilion was organized in well designed with colourful eye-catching stands representing Pakistani highly value added-export oriented Leather Industry. PakistanPavilion was successfully concluded by **Pakistan Tanners Association (PTA)** in **Asia Pacific Leather Fair held from 30 March** to 1 April 2022 at Dubai World Trade Centre in collaboration with the Consulate General of Pakistan, Dubai and with the financial support of EDF Board, Ministry of Commerce, Islamabad & TDAP, Govt., of Pakistan, Karachi for participation of its 25 Regular Member exporters in a most befitting manner for the supreme interest of promoting country's exports via this vital world famous event of Leather Industry.

As a Special Edition in Dubai, there are a total of 463 exhibitors from 35 countries and regions at APLF-Leather, Materials+ and Fashion Access-2022.

Major tanning groups will be present occupying 20,000 square meters of exhibition space with 20 national pavilions from Brazil, Egypt, France, Georgia, India, Italy, Japan, **Pakistan**, Bangladesh, Spain, Turkey, United Kingdom, USA, Uzbekistan and Zimbabwe.

Notably there is an absence of exhibitors from China due to the COVID-19 travel and quarantine restrictions in force. Such restrictions will also impact visitors from China attending APLF in Dubai, but the location of the fair will offer opportunities to buyers from the Indian sub-continent countries to attend.

APLF has worked assiduously with national leather, footwear and retail associations from Egypt, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Turkey, as well as those from Indian sub-continent, Europe and Africa to organize buying groups to APLF Dubai.

During the 3-days Fair, Pakistan Pavilion was fully busy, Alhamdulillahby virtue of wide circulation before the exhibition, an encouraging numbers of foreign buyers/customers from different countries specially from European, which were around 300 to 450 (approx.) visited the Pakistani Stands in APLF-2022 at Dubai from 30 March 2022 to 1 April 2022.

Thistradefairhasbeenproviding international exposure to Pakistanie xhibitors and serving as a platform to mar ket and sell their products. It is also offers an opport unity to get the latest ideas on emerging trends and innovations in the sector. The Fair at international platform provides unique offers to Pakistani member exporters of finished leather to learn a lot with new ongoing trend for finished leather, which was much conducive for the up-gradation. The participation has also been termed to be the real effective platform for making ties/collaborations/joint ventures with various International Business related counterparts, which are in pipeline for finalization.

CONCLUSION OF BUSINESS DURING PTA'S MEMBER EXPORTERS PARTICIPATION

Despite the **pandamic of COVID-19**, the flow of Traffic of foreign buyers/cusomers/visitors to Pakistani booth in National Pavilion of Pakistan during 3 days was found very encouraging as recorded in approximate the total number of **foreign buyers/cusomers visited to the Pakistanibooth were 300 to 450Nos**, from various countries such as **USA**, **Brazil**, **Egypt**, **France**, **Georgia**, **India**, **Italy**, **UK**, **Spain**, **Japan**, **Turkey**, **Uzbekistan**, **Zimbabwe countries etc.**, etc., as revealed from the exhibitors of Pakistan Pavilion, which was recorded with increased reasonably asompared to last event participation made in March'2019 organised by PTA.

In view of the keen interest of the foreign buyers taken in the eye catching innovative Pakistani Leather during the show, all the member exhibitors concerned from PTA were found satisfy this year with the outcome of the Fair and accordingly confirmed their participation in the next edition of APLF-2023 with the same spirit for the promotion of country's exports to the desired extent.

All the Pakistani member participants of PTA have confirmed their participation in the next year exhibition of **APLF-2023**, which is expected to be expanded with more induction of member exporters for participation under the banner of National Pavilion of Pakistan.

As per reports received from the member participants of **National Pavilion of Pakistan**, the encouraging business in enormous was concluded during the **3 Days Show** by the member participants, which worth of **US\$ 10-12 Million(approx)** on valued added finsihed leather of Cow, Buffalo, Sheep & Goat skins during the Fair while worthwhile queries in Millions, which could be around **US\$ 4-5Million (approx)** are in the pipeline for negotiation & finalisation very shortly.

It was the general view/consent of the participants to hold the next APLF'2023 either in Hongkong or Thailand as already sought for by the organizer during the participation in APLF'22, at Dubai.

SUMMARY

100% cost of space rent for 303sqm for 25 participants reserved for National Pavilion of Pakistan in APLF – 30 March – 1 April 2022 at Dubai was US\$ 166,269.77 and 100% construction/decoration of stands charges for was US\$ 36,156.75 which were already paid to the respective organizations via telegraphic transfer thru Bank with due approval of SBP as full & final settlement of their Invoice amounts. Both the Original Invoices of Space Rent & Construction have already got attested by the Consulate General of Pakistan, Dubai for onward submission to TDAP, Karachi for releasing due eligible 25% subsidy on Stand Cost ONLYas has already been approved by EDF/MOC for facilitation to the member participants of the Fair.

I also really appreciate the vigorous efforts of **Mr. Muhammad Ali, Secretary General, PTA** in organizing National Pavilion in this event at Dubai in a most befitting manner.
